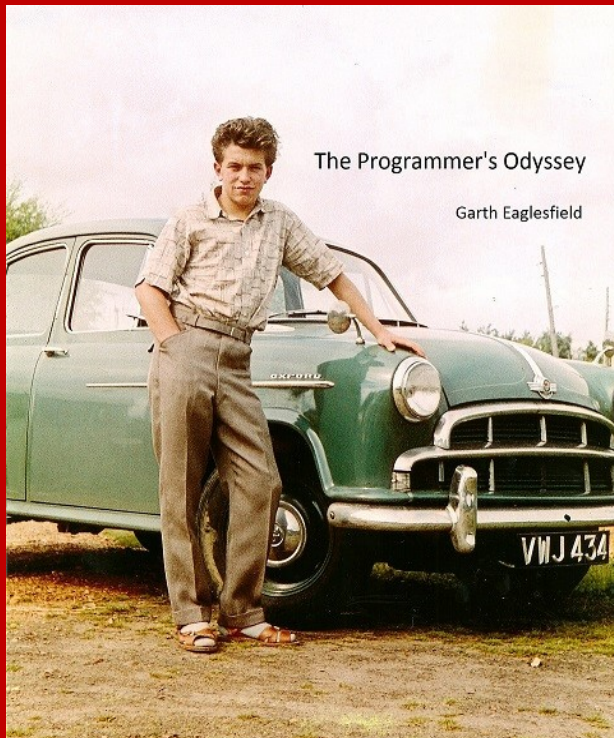


The Programmer's Odyssey
